Family Hospice and Palliative Care offers different levels of services to meet the varying needs of patients, families, friends and caregivers. Care is provided where you live – in your home, a personal care or nursing home, the hospital or one of our hospice facilities.

Your Family Hospice and Palliative Care team will help you transition seamlessly between settings and levels of care when needed and desired.

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH FAMILY HOSPICE AND PALLIATIVE CARE?

Family Hospice and Palliative Care provides a wide range of services in order to meet the individual needs of all patients and their loved ones. The hospice team coordinates regular visits by nurses, home health aides and social workers in order to optimize the patient's comfort and quality of life. If desired, the spiritual care counselor or volunteer may visit to listen and offer support. Therapies such as physical, speech and occupational are available as well as complementary therapies including massage, music, art and pet therapy to aid in self-expression and well being.

WITH FAMILY HOSPICE AND PALLIATIVE CARE, YOU CAN KEEP YOUR OWN DOCTOR.

Your physician is an integral part of the Family Hospice and Palliative care team. The hospice nurse is your physician's eyes and ears, and makes recommendations to address pain and other symptoms. With the Family Hospice and Palliative care team, your physician directs a plan of care that is tailored to your unique needs. Regular communication with your physician is an important component of Hospice and Palliative Care services.

HOSPICE AND PALLIATIVE CARE SERVICES ARE COVERED BY INSURANCE.

Most major healthcare plans, including Medicare and Medicaid, cover hospice and palliative care services. Coverage generally includes visits by the Hospice and Palliative Care team, medical equipment such as a hospital bed, wheelchair or oxygen, therapies and medications.

The Hospice Program focuses on a plan for living, addressing your comfort and quality of life.

The Palliative Home Care Program is for those who are seeking treatment for the life-limiting illness.
